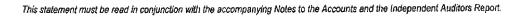

1) STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial statements are for Supporting Families in Mental Illness Nelson Branch Inc. Supporting Families in Mental Illness Nelson Branch Inc is domiciled in New Zealand and is a charitable organisation registered under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957 and the Charities Act 2005.

Supporting Families in Mental Illness Nelson Branch Inc has elected to apply PBE SFR-C (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting Accrual (Not for Profit) as established by the External Reporting Board for registered charities, on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000.

All Transactions in the Statement of Financial Performance are reported using the accounting. The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of earnings and financial position on an historical basis have been used, with the exception of certain items for which specific accounting policies have been identified.

The financial Statements are prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on a bases consistent with those used in previous years.

Specific Accounting Policies

In the preparation of these financial statements, the specific accounting policies are as follows:

(a) Property, Plant & Equipment

All property, plant & equipment except for land is stated at cost less depreciation Depreciation has been calculated in accordance with rates permitted under the Income Tax Act 2007.

(b) Goods & Services Tax

These financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis with the exception of accounts receivable and accounts payable which are shown inclusive of GST.

(c) Revenue

Interest income is recognised using the effective interest method.

(d) Taxation

Supporting Families in Mental Illness Nelson Branch Inc is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

(e) Fundraising and Grants

Grants received are included in operating revenue. If particular conditions are attached to a grant that would require it to be repaid if these conditions are not met, then the grant is recorded as a liability until the conditions are satisfied.

(f) Donations

Donations received are included in operating revenue. If particular conditions are attached to a donation that would require it to be repaid if these conditions are not met, then the donation is recorded as a liability until the conditions are satisfied. Donated goods or services (other than donated assets) are not recognised.

Where significant donated assets are received with useful lives of 12 months or more, and the fair value of the asset is readily obtainable, the donation is recorded at the value of the asset obtained. Where the fair value of the asset is not readily obtainable, the donation is not recorded. Donated assets with useful lives less than 12 months are not recorded.

(g) Receivables

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

(h) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the entity has a present obligation (legal or constructive) as a result of a past event and it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of the obligation.
